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1. Introduction

Bios is committed to compliance with the legislation in force by the Regulation 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and the free movement of such data, applicable from 25 May 2018 (hereinafter the “General Data Protection Regulation“ or GDPR).¹

2. Entity Responsible for Data

3. Personal Data Collected

Personal data is collected by Bios for the following reasons:

- Identifying information such as name, surname, gender, professional function, email address, address, phone number, country, organization;
- Search engine and keywords used to find the website;
- Individual photos, pictures and videos taken at events, quotes from statements made during meetings and any other data related to meetings and event or relevant for administrative purposes.

Personal data may be collected from open data sources or interaction on Bios website, registration and participation to events organized by Bios and subscription to its monthly newsletter.


Bios does not use any Third-Party service provider to collect personal data on its behalf.

There is limited risk of violating fundamental rights as Bios takes adequate measures to ensure data security. Bios ensures compliance with this data privacy policy by taking appropriate measures to ensure that the data storage system prevents any unauthorized leak, destruction, loss, disclosure, use, access or modification of personal data. In case any data breach occurs, Bios will immediately take action to secure its data base.

4. Data Use for Communication

Bios collects data mainly to keep interested stakeholders informed about the latest news and activities of the company and to better understand our market mainly for communication purposes. Bios

Bios obtains prior and informed consent of its communication recipients before providing any confidential, proprietary or privileged data. The possibility of withdrawing any prior explicit consent by a concerned party can be exercised at any time by contacting Bios.

5. Privacy rights

Bios ensures that the following list of rights can be asserted anytime:

- Right to be informed about the purposes of the processing and the identity of the data controller;
- Right of access and verification of data;
- Right of objection;
- Right of cancellation and/or modification;
- Right of unsubscribing to communications;
- Request the deletion of all personal data from the database, object to the use and request the limitation by sending a written request.
